ADVERTISING ON PARISH COUNCIL LAND

Last Updated: January 2018

There is to be no advertising on Parish Council land without the prior consent from Eaton Bray Parish Council, the Council will remove any unauthorised advertising within the parish.

Sponsored advertising boards must be able to clearly show the sponsored event and not be overshadowed by the organisation sponsoring the signage. Inappropriate signage will be removed or the organisation sponsoring the event will be asked to replace them with more suitable signage.

Advertising boards (if approved) can be placed in the following locations and must be removed immediately after the event:

- (1) Entry to village (Harling Road): 1x sign
- (2) Entry to village (The Rye triangle): 1x sign
- (3) Three Corners: 1x sign
- (4) Market Square: 1x sign

Those wishing to advertise on Parish Council land must complete the application form and forward to the Parish Clerk for final decision by the Council.

All applications for advertising boards/signage on parish land must be applied for on an annual basis.
